

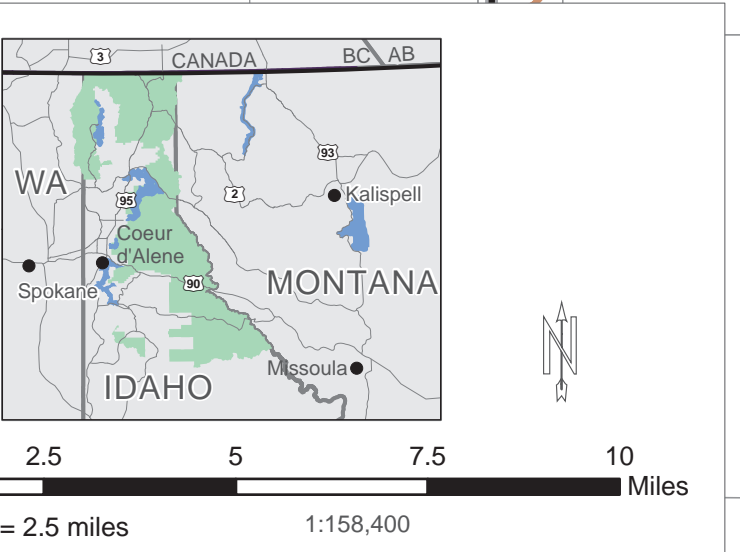
IDAHO PANHANDLE NATIONAL FORESTS (NORTH HALF) LAND MANAGEMENT PLAN (Alternative B Modified)
